Students must fulfill foreign language for graduation from the Bachelor of Science program by completing either 2 years of the same foreign language while in high school or by completing 2 semesters of the same foreign language while in college. _____

Additional Admission Requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education at Edison State College:

1. An overall GPA of 2.5 on all hours earned (including all transfer courses)
2. Passing scores on all subsections of the General Knowledge Test (GK), CLAST, or Praxis I. Students who submit CLAST scores for admission may not use waivers, exemptions or alternative satisfactions.
3. Completion of all general education (A.A. degree) and required program prerequisites (above). Students who transfer to Edison State College with a previously earned Associate in Arts degree (from a Florida community college or State University) or a Bachelor's degree have met the general education requirements for the B.S. **Students must complete a minimum of sixty (60) credit hours for admission.**
4. Students must be fingerprinted and screened by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the FBI prior to entering any school. Students must disclose background information that may preclude them from becoming certified at the time of admission.
