Painting On Silk

Fabric Dyeing & Surface Designs

There is a magic that happens when brush after brush of colored dye is applied to a stretched piece of silk. The colors have a way of floating on the surface and blending into wonderful shapes that have been created with a water soluble resist. Whether your interest is in creating landscapes, waterscapes, nature objects, abstract images or other ideas, it can be painted using MX Fiber-Reactive Dyes. This is a **six (6)** week course.

Materials: Package of 7 or 9 oz Clear Plastic Glasses
Package of Plastic Spoons
Roll Of Paper Towels
6B Pencil
½" 3-Ring Binder
Paint Brushes- Flat Nylon or acrylic sizes ½", ¾"
Round Nylon or Acrylic Sizes 2, 6, 8

Starter Kit- Dyes & Fabric etc. will be supplied to each student for \$30.00. This is payable to the instructor on the first night.
